### Beginning of the Accem Observatories Network

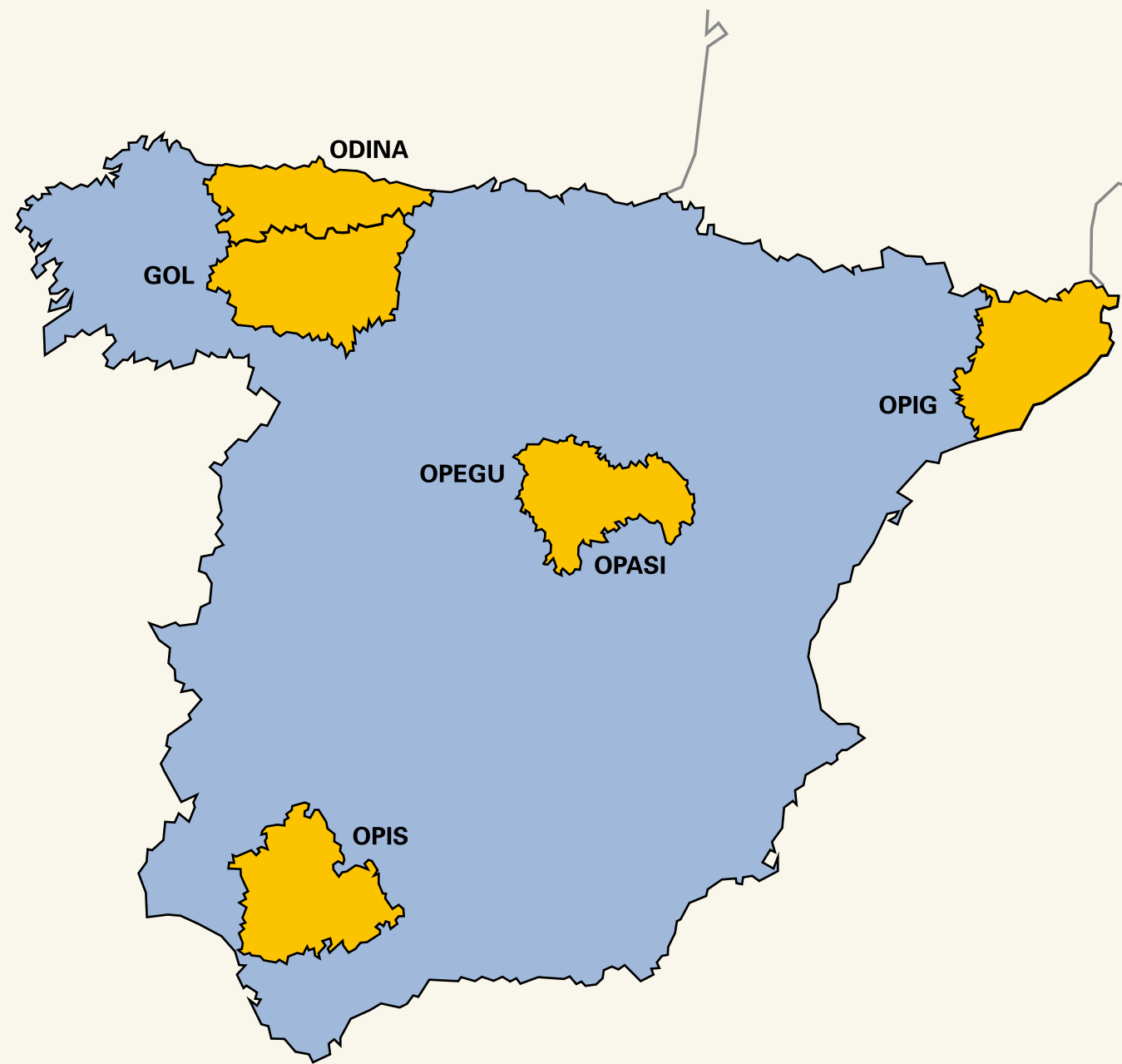
In 1998, Accem created and started up the Permanent Observatory of Immigration of Asturias - ODINA (Observatorio Permanente de la Inmigración de Asturias-ODINA) and the Local Observatory of Sigüenza (Observatorio Local de Sigüenza) with the collaboration of the Université de Franche-Comté in Besançon (France). Both are based on the Territorial Intelligence principles and on the Catalyse methodology.

### Evolution and expansion

The Permanent Observatory of Immigration of Asturias (ODINA) ([www.odina.info](http://www.odina.info)), in addition to its regional observation field, reinforced the observation prospect at the local level with the articulation of two Local Observatories, those of Gijón and Oviedo (2005). The Observatory of Sigüenza ([www.opasi.es](http://www.opasi.es)) also created at the province level the Observatory of Guadalajara (Observatorio de Guadalajara) ([www.opegu.es](http://www.opegu.es)) in 2005.

Location and starting up of these new Observatories were made in territories where Accem was working and where there was an experience of work processes development in network and in partnership with authorities and institutions. This starting up was made from a research and action prospect. This observation strategy aimed to reinforce and enhance the cooperative intervention networks on the territory.

New observatories were created with the same methodology in Sevilla y León in 2006, and in Alzira (Valencia) and Girona (Cataluña) in 2007.



### Purpose of the Observatories Network

- Knowing the socio-economic reality of the immigrant group
- Developing the local actors participation
- Starting up strategies and actions in favour of the fight against migrant people's precariousness and exclusion

### Accem Participation to caENTI

Accem participation to the caENTI project is mainly focused on developing protocols and users' guide of the tools of the Catalyse methodology, so as to mobilize the partnership and the Observation Groups. It allows harmonizing the protocols used by the Observatories that made up the Accem Observatories Network.

Accem provides to caENTI its experience of body involved in the development and execution of programmes and services of social and professional integration for migrant people.
