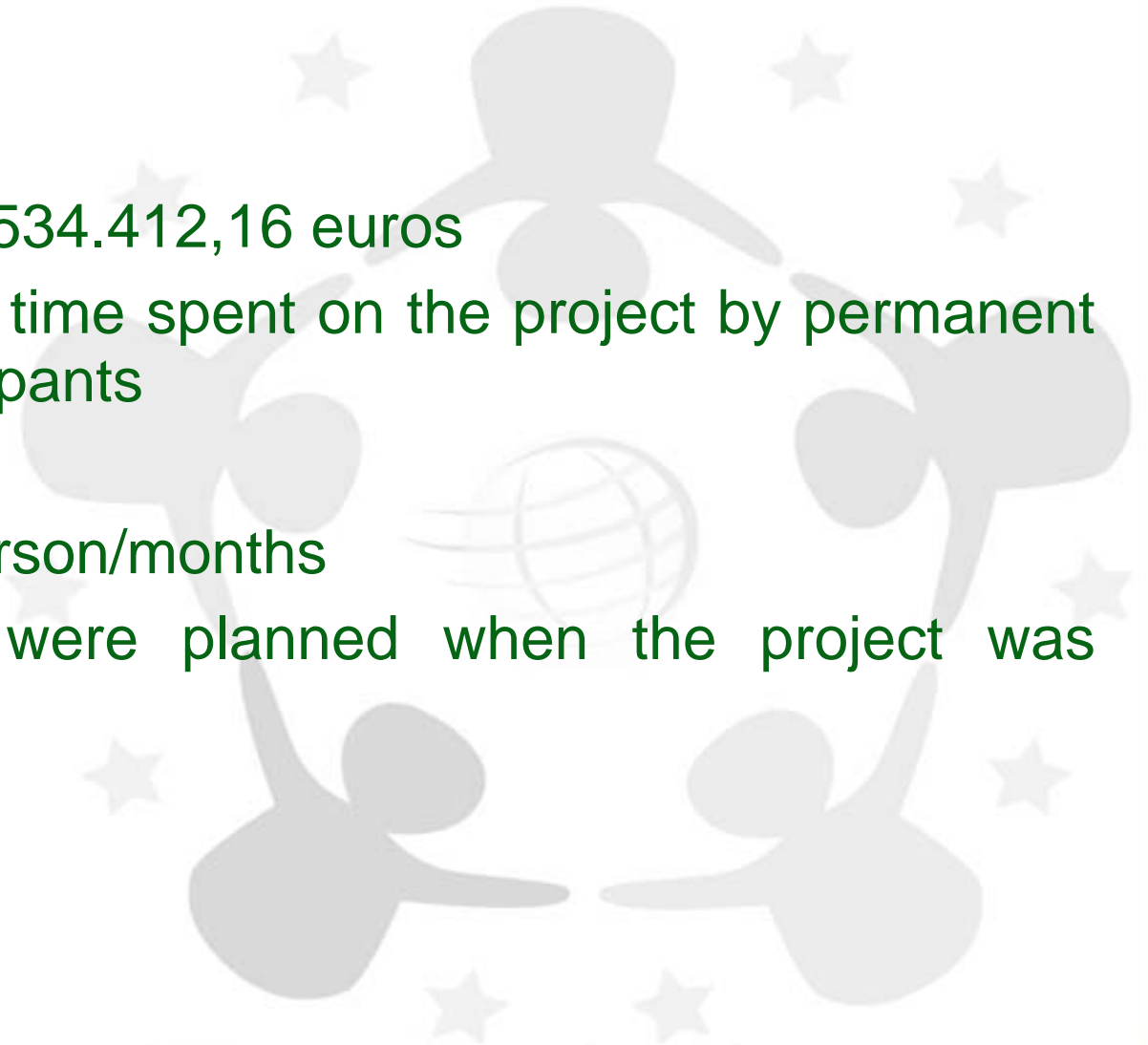
# Main data about management

Total efforts: 438,95 person/months


276,5 person/months were planned when the project was launched
